Use commas to set off parenthetical elements Example: You should, nevertheless, continue to work hard.
Use parentheses to set off parenthetical elements Example : The last person who leaves (if anyone manages to get out) needs to close the door.
Use dashes to set off nonrestrictive elements Example : There is no way-and no reason- to climb the mountain.
Use subjective pronouns (he, she, I)
Use objective pronouns (me, him, us)
Use possessive pronouns (mine, yours, ours, theirs)
Use intensive pronouns (myself, yourselves, ourselves)
Use pronouns introduced after the specific person/place/thing has already been named
Align pronoun number and person/place/thing
Use correct spelling
