

LPS Grade 6 Conventions Checklist



- Use commas to set off parenthetical elements
Example: You should, nevertheless, continue to work hard.
- Use parentheses to set off parenthetical elements
Example: The last person who leaves (if anyone manages to get out) needs to close the door.
- Use dashes to set off nonrestrictive elements
Example: There is no way-and no reason- to climb the mountain.
- Use subjective pronouns (*he, she, I*)
- Use objective pronouns (*me, him, us*)
- Use possessive pronouns (*mine, yours, ours, theirs*)
- Use intensive pronouns (*myself, yourselves, ourselves*)
- Use pronouns introduced after the specific person/place/thing has already been named
- Align pronoun number and person/place/thing
- Use correct spelling
